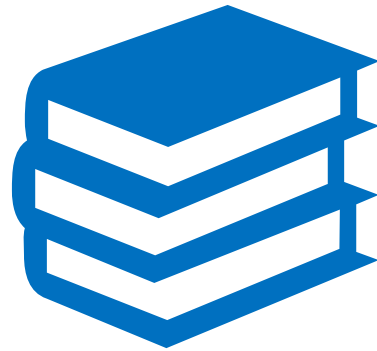


Reading
