Cost

For the full week of activities, staffing and transport the cost will be £80.

Can I pay in instalments?

Yes – the payment plan will be clear on the letter.

Does my child have to take part in all activities?

No, but we highly recommend it. Unfortunately, due to the way in which the school subsidise and pay for the week, the full amount will still be payable.

Will the school provide lunch/food for each of the days?

The school provides food for some activities, in most cases they will need to bring a packed lunch or order one from the school kitchen prior to the date of the activity.
