Breaktime Snacks

At breaktime, children are allowed a piece of fruit or a cereal bar. No crisps, biscuits etc will be allowed to be consumed. This will be confiscated by staff members and put in the child's lunchbox.

Lunches

We have changed catering provider this year and we are slowly ironing out any issues. The quality of the food had taken a great leap already just in the first few days. Please remember that we are a no nuts school as we have severe allergies amongst staff and pupils; this includes chocolate spread and peanut butter in sandwiches.

Uniform

Please see the school uniform policy on the website but please be aware that hooped earrings, trainers and jewellery (except for a wristwatch) are not permitted. We have been impressed with the PE kits so far this year but please remember that all children should have a PE kit in school. Earrings need to be removed for PE so if your child cannot remove them independently, please remove them before school otherwise they will not be able to join in with PE.

Attendance

Thank you to everyone that gets their children to school in good time in the morning. At Benyon we take attendance and punctuality very seriously and follow up each day if children are not in school or their attendance/ punctuality becomes a concern. If you are struggling to get your child into school, then please speak to someone in the office or send an email so that we can support you.
