

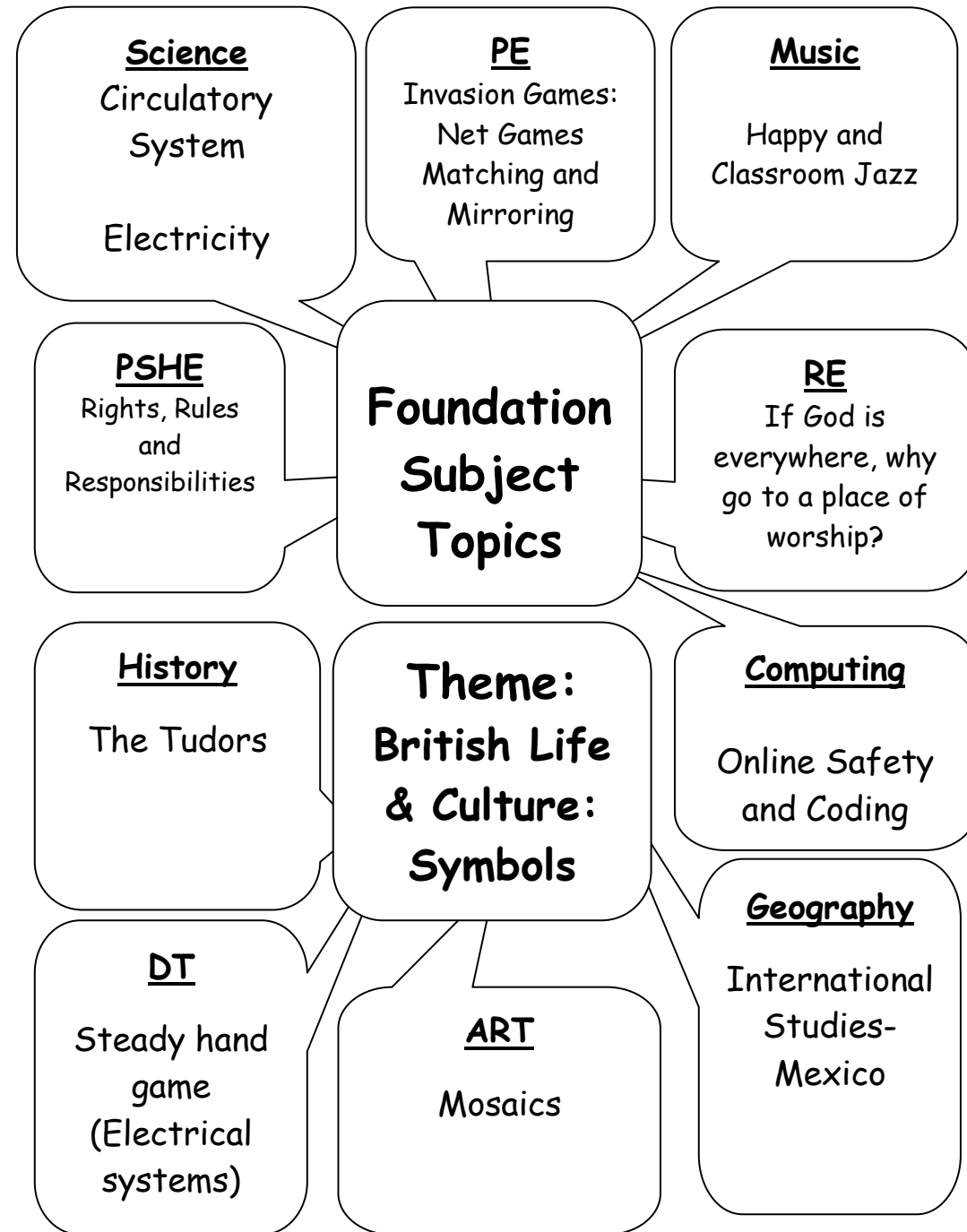
Autumn Term

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to another exciting and challenging year at Benyon Primary School. This information letter will inform you all about what our Year 6 children will experience this term.

In English, the units we will be covering are: letter writing, narrative writing, biographies and reports. Our book is *Private Peaceful*. We will also have daily Guided Reading sessions which will help promote children's reading skills.

In Maths, we will start with a 'mental' starter activity which will mainly focus on times tables, number knowledge and promote mental Maths skills. The main part of the lessons will be focussed on place value, arithmetic, shape and space and problem solving skills. We will also look at Measurement towards the end of the term. The focus will be on increasing the pupils' independence through generating ideas and building on their problem solving skills as well as adapting their understanding to different types of questions.
